Project-Based Learning with Google Earth

After downloading Google Earth (http://earth.google.com/download-earth.html) you can:

1. Create Places:

- **a.** Search for a location you want by typing a location in the search bar, or scroll around the map using the directional arrows on the right-hand side of the map
- **b.** Add a placemark by clicking on the pin icon (use placemarks to permanently mark locations)
- **c.** Add a second location by searching again, or by using the directional arrows on the right-hand side of the map, then placing a second pin at your next location

2. Add/Edit Information on a Placemark:

a. Move Pinpoints

- i. Place your mouse over your new placemark
- ii. Click and drag the pushpin to your desired location

b. Change the Name and Description on your pinpoints

- i. In the Places menu (on the left-hand side of the screen), right click on the location you have pinpointed
- ii. Select the bottom option from the drop down menu. (It will read either "Properties" or "Get Information" depending on if you use a PC or a Mac.)

c. Change the Pushpin Icon

- i. On the Properties (or Get Information) menu, click the picture of your pushpin on the right-hand upper corner
- ii. Select a new icon from the menu or upload one from your computer by clicking the "Custom Icon" button

d. Add Images to your Placemarks

- i. In the Places menu on the left-hand side of the screen, right click on the location you want to edit
- ii. Go to "Add" and choose either Image Overlay or Picture
- iii. Upload an image from your computer

e. Add Video to your Placemarks:

- i. In the Places menu (on the left-hand side of the screen) right click on the location you have pinpointed
- ii. Select the bottom option from the drop down menu (Properties or Get Information)
- iii. Copy the embed code from the video you want to include
- iv. Paste it in the Description box

3. Create Tours:

- **a.** After creating a series of Placemarks:
 - i. Click on the Video Camera icon or select Create Tour from the dropdown menus at the top of the screen
 - ii. In the Places menu on the left-hand side, double click on the places you have pinpointed in the order you want to view them in the tour
 - iii. Google Earth will record your tour in the order you select
 - iv. Save your tour

4. Save Everything you have Created for Exporting:

- a. Make certain everything you want to include is checked
- **b.** Right click on the file and select "Save As" from the drop down menu
- c. Name the file and save it to your desktop
- **d.** When you click to open the file from your desktop it will open in Google Earth as a complete place with a blue "Google Earth" world icon, and you can keep it as a permanent "Place" in your "My Places"

5. Export Files:

- **a.** Right click on the file you want to export in your "Places" menu (make sure that the file has the blue Google Earth icon, or any pictures/videos/etc. will not be sent with the file)
- **b.** Choose Email in the drop down menu and email it to yourself or others
